This is where the Byway State Route #27 starts, its run through historic towns, authentic culture, and spectacular scenery. This byway offers travelers outdoor adventures, visitor services and amenities. Along the byway, at the town of Carrabassett Valley, There are big outdoor recreational opportunities, such as highly rated golf and downhill skiing facilities, and over 65 miles of cross-country ski trails.
