0.0	0.0	Junction	Junction of State Route #75 with #75A at Robertstown, Georgia withint Chattahoochee National Forest, Georgia, starts Russell-Brasstown Scenic Byway it's journey through the Chattahoochee National Forest. The byway winds through the valleys and mountain gaps of the southern Appalachians. From the vistas atop Brasstown Bald, to the cooling mists of waterfalls, scenic wonders are abundant on this byway. Unicoi State Park, Lake Unicoi, is located east of this location. Altitude: 1463 feet	44.2	71.2
0.7	1.1	Tray Mountain Road	Tray Mountain Road, Anna Ruby Falls is located off this road. Tray Mountain, with an elevation of 4,430 feet, is the seventh-highest peak in Georgia. Blood Mountain Pass Neel Gap, Byron Reese Trail, to Blood Mountain, is the highest peak on the Georgia section of the Appalachian Trail. There are many waterfalls, hiking trails and other recreational areas in the vicinity. Slaughter Mountain, a peak in Georgia.
