20.6	33.2	Round Pond Road	Round Pond Road, Dodge Pond, a large pond located just off State Route #16 (part of the Rangeley Lakes Scenic Byway), Lost Logans Road, Lost Logan, Altitude: 1591 feet	15.9	25.6
21.3	34.3	Mingo Loop Road	Mingo Loop Road, runs along the shores of Rangeley Lake, a lake located in Franklin County, Maine. The lake is one of the major headwater lakes of the Androscoggin watershed. Its elevation is 1,518 feet above sea level and its area is about 10 square miles. Altitude: 1791 feet	15.2	24.5
23.1	37.2	Loon Lake Road	Loon Lake Road, Ross Pond, Steven A. Bean Municipal Airport, Bud Russell Road, to Kennebago Pond, located off Rangeley Lakes Scenic Byway in Maine Altitude: 1532 feet	13.4	21.6
23.6	37.9	Rangeley, Maine	At this location State Route #16 detours from the byway and travels northerly to Stratton, Maine. Rangeley, Maine, a town in Franklin County, Maine, Rangeley is the center of the Rangeley Lakes Region, a resort area. The town includes the villages of Oquossoc, Haines Landing and South Rangeley.
