On the Lookout Mountain Scenic Highway/USA Highway #76/State Highway #2, Southern Highroads Trail, continues its journey into South Carolina and enters Sumpter National Forest, South Carolina. Along its route, South Carolina part of the Byway offers visitors the opportunity to experience the excitement of whitewater rafting on the famous Chattooga River, SC, hiking and horseback riding along mountain trails, camping at numerous sites, fishing in crystal-clear waters and playing golf on championship courses.
