0.8	1.3	Welcome to Fabulous Las Vegas Sign	The Welcome to Fabulous Las Vegas sign, a Las Vegas Strip landmark, The design is characteristic of the Googie architecture movement. The sign is currently located in the median at 5100 Las Vegas Boulevard South, north of the historic stone pillars of the old McCarran Airport on the east side, It is considered by some to be the official southern end of the Las Vegas Strip. 1.4	2.3	Road to Mandalay Bay	Road to Mandalay Bay, The Mandalay Bay Convention Center, located in Paradise, Nevada, is one of the largest privately owned and operated convention centers in the world. 1.7	2.8	Road to Luxor Las Vegas	Road to Luxor Las Vegas, The Luxor Las Vegas, a hotel and casino located on the Las Vegas Strip in Paradise, Nevada. It was one of the city's first fully-themed megaresorts. Built and named in honor of an Ancient Egyptian motif and contains a total of 4,407 rooms. Named after the city of Luxor (ancient Thebes) in Egypt. Altitude: 2142 feet	3.5	5.6
1.9	3.1	Excalibur Hotel and Casino	Excalibur Hotel and Casino, a hotel and casino located on the Las Vegas Strip in Paradise, Nevada, The style of the hotel is heavily based on the castle in Carcassone, France. The Mandalay Bay Tram, a long people mover, constructed to connect three gaming hotels belonging to the MGM Mirage Group, namely, Excalibur Hotel, Casino and Luxor Hotel and Mandalay Bay Resort and Casino. The Tropicana Resort & Casino Las Vegas is located on the Las Vegas Strip, in Las Vegas, Nevada east of this location. Altitude: 2136 feet	3.3	5.3
2.1	3.3	Intersection	Intersection Tropicana Avenue, The Tropicana - Las Vegas Boulevard intersection on the Las Vegas Strip was the first intersection in Las Vegas completely closed to street level pedestrian traffic and its four corners are home to four major resorts: Excalibur Hotel and Casino, Tropicana Resort & Casino, New York-New York Hotel & Casino and MGM Grand Las Vegas ? the latter being the largest hotel in the world, with 5,044 rooms. The resorts at the four corners have a total of 12,890 hotel rooms as of 2004. Altitude: 2129 feet	3.2	5.1
2.5	4.1	East Harmon Avenue	E Harmon Avenue, MGM Grand Adventures Theme Park, a theme park adjacent to the MGM Grand hotel and casino, closed to the public on September 4, 2000 after it showed a bad performance. The theme park was renamed The Park at MGM Grand and served as a rental facility. CityCenter, a mixed-use complex. Desert Passage at Aladdin, The Theatre for the Performing Arts, a 7,000 seat theater located in the Planet Hollywood Resort and Casino, Altitude: 2123 feet	2.7	4.3
2.8	4.5	Bellagio Drive	Bellagio, an AAA Five-Diamond, Mobil Five-Star rated luxury hotel and casino located on the Las Vegas Strip in the Paradise area of Clark County, Nevada, The Cosmopolitan Resort & Casino, a resort casino and condo just south of the Bellagio on the west side of the Las Vegas Strip. Paris Las Vegas, a hotel and casino located on Las Vegas Strip in Paradise, Nevada, Altitude: 2113 feet	2.4	3.9

This Musuem exhibits American nuclear history, A "Ground Zero Theater" which simulates the experience of observing an atmospheric nuclear test. Other displays focus on important figures at the facility, videos and interactive exhibits about radiation. The New Las Vegas Arena, a description of a 20,000-seat multi-purpose arena in Las Vegas, Nevada, The Playboy Club, a nightclub located on the 52nd floor of the Fantasy Tower at the Palms Hotel Casino, Altitude: 2110 feet	2.2	3.5
