At the Junction of United States Highway #191 with United States Highway #60 starts the Byway Coronado Trail Scenic Byway. Byway travels through high desert and forests, and travelers can see former Native American footpaths. Touristic attraction of Springerville, Arizona is : Casa Malpais, which is located near Springerville. The Springerville volcanic field contains over 400 volcanoes within a fifty mile radius of Springerville, making it the third largest volcanic field in the continental United States.
