The laboratory is one of the largest science and technology institutions in the world that conducts multidisciplinary research for fields such as national security, outer space, renewable energy, medicine, nanotechnology, and supercomputing. This is where Byway Jemez Mountain Trail begins its run, through time, past amazing geological formations, ancient Indian ruins, and an Indian pueblo. Sites the byway passes through are; Jemez State Monument, Bandelier National Monument, Soda Dam, Cabezon, Battleship Rock, and the Spence and Jemez Mountain Hot Springs.
