On United States Highway #287/State Highway #14, starts Byway Cache le Poudre-North Park scenic and historic Byway starts it's journey towards the quiet, bowl-shaped valley of North Park, located just west of the Continental Divide. Recreation along the byway is high on visitorsâ€™ lists. The Poudre River, Coloradoâ€™s only federally designated National Wild and Scenic River, is a popular spot for whitewater boaters and anglers. Parking lots on the east and west sides of the pass, as well as at the summit allow access to nearby trails that are popular both for hiking in the summer and cross-country skiing in the winter. The pass receives much snow during the winter months and is prone to avalanches, but it usually remains open all-year round. The pass has a mild approach from the East, and is steep from the West.
