0.0	0.0	Georgetown, Colorado	Georgetown, Colorado, is a town in Clear Creek County, Colorado. The federally designated Georgetown-Silver Plume National Historic District comprises Georgetown, the neighboring Town of Silver Plume, and the Georgetown Loop Historic Mining & Railroad Park between the two towns. This is where Byway Guanella Pass Road starts its journey towards Grant, Colorado. This byway leap-frogs the steep divide between the South Platte and Clear Creek watersheds, passing through a succession of distinct environments. There are well-established trails to explore the Rocky Mountains along the Byway. Hiking, horseback riding, biking, and backcountry exploring are all popular activities along the trails.
