Peak to Peak Scenic and Historic Byway starts here on State Route #119. This byway offers spectacular views of the Front Range, the Continental Divide and its timbered approaches. Attractions along the byway are Rocky Mountain National Park, Golden Gate Canyon State Park, Arapaho and Roosevelt National Forests, the Indian Peaks Wilderness Area, and Eldora Ski Resort - combine recreation with nature preservation.
