Volcanism and glaciation formed more than 150 lakes for which the region is well known. High Desert Museum and Tower Theatre are places of touristic interest in the city of Bend, Oregon. State Route #380, Broken Top, a stratovolcano highly eroded by glaciation, located south of the Three Sisters group of volcanoes in the Cascade Range of central Oregon and within the Three Sisters Wilderness.
