0.0	0.0	Junction	Junction of United States Highway #14 with United States Highway #14A in the Big Horn National Forest, along Tongue River, Wyoming. Byway Medicine Wheel Passage starts at this location, Wyoming Highway 14A, known as the Medicine Wheel Passage, rises from the Big Horn Basin to high elevation range land. 7.5	12.0	Pullover/Viewpoint	Pullover/ Viewpoint, to view the scenic landscape of the Big Horn Mountains and Big Horn National Forest along the medicine Wheel Passage, Wyoming. Altitude: 8422 feet	19.8	31.9

20.8	33.5	Road Access	Road Access to Medicine wheels, or sacred hoops, were constructed by laying stones in a particular pattern on the ground. Medicine wheels are stone structures constructed by certain indigenous peoples of North America for various astronomical, ritual, healing, and teaching purposes. The Bighorn Medicine Wheel is a medicine wheel located in the Big Horn Mountains in Wyoming. The structure is located at an altitude of nearly 10,000 feet, near the summit of Medicine Mountain. It is a precolumbian structure, built from roughly loaf-sized stones gathered from the surrounding area. Altitude: 9072 feet	6.5	10.4
