This byway offers spectacular views and a unique history. Breathtaking beauty of Wyoming, world-class opportunities for wildlife viewing, a variety of recreation opportunities, and a chance to see the land where the legendary flight of Chief Joseph and his band of Nez Perce occurred are the specialties of traveling this byway. | 46.3 | 74.5 | Junction | Junction of State Route #296/Chief Joseph Scenic Highway with Bear Tooth Highway/United States Highway #212. This is where Chief Joseph Scenic Highway ends at. Altitude: 7113 feet | 0.0 | 0.0 |
