Large portions of the town are covered by the White Mountain National Forest. Loon Mountain ski resort is located here in Lincoln, New Hampshire. Attractions in the town are; Clark's Trading Post, Hobo Railroad, Indian Head Resort, Papermill Theatre, North Country Center for the Arts, New Hampshire Highland Games, Upper Pemigewasset Historical Society Museum, Whale's Tale Water Park. This is where Kancamagus Scenic Byway starts its easterly journey to terminate at Conway, New Hampshire Altitude: 764 feet	35.1	56.5

Loon Mountain Ski Resort, an all-season recreation area located here, hosts the finals for the northeast circuit of the Mountain Dew Vertical Challenge on the last Saturday of March or first Saturday of April each ski season.
