0.0	0.0	Junction of US11 and State 606	Steels Tavern Virginia is the Eastern end of SR606. This road is designated a Virginia Byway and also serves as bike route 76. Take your time enjoy the views and drive carefully.	13.3	21.4
0.5	0.8	McCormick Memorial Wayside	The 'Walnut Grove Farm' was the birthplace of the mechanical reaper that Cryus McCormick improved and patterned. The wayside provides shady tables for a picnic, restroom facilities. A self guided tour of the grain mill and blacksmiths shop is recommended.	12.8	20.6
1.4	2.3	Junction Interstate 81 and 64	Whites Truck Stop has been on this location since interstate 81 was constructed. The restaurant is eclectic and worth the stop. Don't expect gourmet food just a good old fashioned truck stop food.	11.9	19.2

5.5	8.9	Wades Mill and BuffaloHerb Farm	Wade's Mill is a working water-powered flourmill listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The mill is powered by a 21-foot water wheel still produces a wide variety of flours exclusively on mill stones. The Herb Farm offers garden tours with a variety of themes, the plant house stocked with herb plants and garden accessories and the Big Red Barn where herbal products, dried flowers and designs and garden books may be purchased.	7.8	12.6

8.0	12.9	Brownsburg, Virginia	Brownsburg, Virginia was settled in 1793 and served as a waypoint on the stage line from Staunton, Virginia to Lexington, Virginia. Today you can visit antique shops and the Brownsburg Tea Room in a restored log cabin.	5.3	8.5
