0.0	0.0	Junction US2 and M117	Highway M117 connects the US2 lakeshore east-west route with the northern highway M28 east-west route in Michigan's beautiful Upper Peninsula.	14.0	22.5
1.0	1.6	Engadine	Small northern community of Engadine was founded in 1894 during northern Michigan's lumbering era. Today the community's economy is based on agriculture, tourism and logging. Don't miss the Mill Pond Park with native wildflower plantings, a gazebo, picnic area and well-maintained walking trails. The Freeman-Hastings House museum on Mackinac Trail is open Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday afternoons.	13.0	20.9
6.0	9.7	Bethlehem Luthern Church	This country Luthern Church with well lighted cross is a familiar landmark to all who travel M117. The church was founded by immigrant farmers; the congregation continues today.	8.0	12.9
7.0	11.3	Sandtown Road & Sandtown Bed & Breakfast	You'll catch a glimpse of the roof of the Sandtown Farmhouse Bed & Breakfast just west of highway M117. The B&B offers country lodging, breakfast cooked on a woodfired cookstove, gardens, trails for hiking and cross-country skiing. (Snowmobile trail access nearby) Sandtown Road connects with the Manistique Lakes area, northern Michigan's largest inland lakes area.	7.0	11.3
