Pit toilets, picnic tables, grills, and water are available. No Hook-ups. No dump station. NO GENERATORS ALLOWED. Elevation 1,900'. Rio Grande Village Campground: 100 site campground has flush toilets, running water, picnic tables, grills, and some overhead shelters. Dump Station nearby; NO HOOK-UPS. Elevation 1,850'. Rio Grande Village RV Park: 25 sites. This is the ONLY campground with hookups in the park. Boating,</p> <p>Fishing,</p> <p>Kayaking,</p> <p>Whitewater Rafting: The Rio Grande, or El Rio Bravo del Norte, borders Big Bend National Park for 118 miles.
