The museum is located on Boulevard Kukulcan, in the Hotel Zone. - Dolphin Discovery, MX; is located on Isla Mujeres, a 20 minutes on boat from Playa Tortugas, from the Hotel Zone of Cancun, MX. - The Ruinas del Rey is an ancient ruins. These ruins date back to 200 BC. these ruins are located on Blvd. Kukulcan, Cancun. Altitude: 26 feet
